Apprentice Training (AT):

Successfully complete the 10-day Apprenticeship Training (AT) either all at once or in 2-day increments over a 1 year period.

Get certified as an Apprentice.

As an Apprentice, you can <u>teach Levels 1-2</u> and integrate the Method into your existing private practice**.

Post AT (Apprenticeship Training) requirements:

These can be done after AT or FT training.

- Purchase the Apprentice Training Video the "BIBle".
- Assist at another BIB workshop for 10 days (in increments or all at once).
- Complete 30 core cries and submit 10 positive feedback forms to BIB central.
- Practise teaching Levels 1-2 and submit 10 positive feedback forms to BIB central.
- Submit 2 recordings of vourself introducing two of the processes (of your choice) to your group. Preferably, video recordings, but if you are technically challenged, audio is OK. too. We will be looking, mainly, at 2 aspects of your presentation: a) the fullness of your explanation of what and why needs to happen, if the process set up was complete; and b) your quality of presence during facilitation. Submit the electronic evaluation form to BIB central.
- Actively participate in BIB community***.

Facilitator Training (FT):

Successfully complete the 6-day Facilitator Training (FT) either immediately after the 10-day Apprentice Training or at a subsequent BIB workshop.

Get certified as a Facilitator-in-Training if you have not completed the post AT (Apprentice Training) Requirements before attending the Facilitator Training (FT).

As a certified Facilitatorin-Training, you can teach Levels 1-3 and integrate the Method into your existing private practice**. Get certified as a <u>Facilitator</u> when you have successfully completed both the FT (Facilitator Training) and the Post AT (Apprentice Training) requirements.

As a certified Facilitator, you can <u>teach Levels 1-4</u> and integrate the Method into your existing private practice**.

Advanced Facilitator Requirements:

- Accumulate a minimum of 40 days of "credits" ****.
- Run workshops and Submit 40 positive feedback forms from participants/assistants in written/video/audio format.
- Facilitate 50 'Core Cries' or more (20 in addition to the Post AT requirements already completed). Submit an additional 10 positive feedback forms to BIB central.
- Submit 2 additional videos (or audios) of yourself introducing or engaging in different processes than previously submitted.
- Submit the electronic evaluation form.
- Actively participate in the Birth into Being Community (when inactive for more than one year, a 4-day minimum assisting is required to stay current).

As a certified, <u>Advanced</u>
<u>Facilitator</u> you can teach Levels
1-5 and integrate the Method
into your existing private
practice**.

- * Certification at each step is at the discretion of the Regional Chief Advocating Officer (CAO).
- ** Give credit to the Birth into Being Method when integrating into an existing private practice by informing clients when you use if and by including the Birth into Being Method credentials in all promotional and biographical materials.
- *** If inactive in the BIB community for more than 1 year, then a minimum of 4-days of assisting is required.
- **** "Credit" days include assistance, teaching own BIB seminars, participation in facilitator practice meetings, etc.
